## Hagar

**Gen 16:7** *The angel of the LORD found her by a spring of water in the wilderness, the spring on the way to Shur.*

## Moses

## Manoah

3. The titles of the Lord Jesus Christ indicate His eternal being

He is precisely what His names imply. He is "The Son of God," "The Only Begotten Son," "The First and the Last," "The Alpha and Omega," "The Lord," "Lord of All," "Lord of Glory," "The Christ," "Wonderful," "Counsellor," "The Mighty God," "The Father of Eternity," "God," "God With Us," "Our Great God," and "God Blessed Forever."

These titles relate Him to the Old Testament revelation of Jehovah-God

**Mat 1:23** *"Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall call his name Immanuel" (which means, God with us).*

**Isa 7:14** *Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign. Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.*

**Mat 4:7** *Jesus said to him, "Again it is written, 'You shall not put the Lord your God to the test.'"*

**Deut 6:16** *"You shall not put the LORD your God to the test, as you tested him at Massah.*



The New Testament names of the Son of God are associated with titles of the Father and the Spirit as being equal with them

**Mat 28:19** *Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,*

**John 14:1** *"Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me.*

**Act 2:38** *And Peter said to them, "Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.*

## **Chapter Seven:**

### **God the Son-His Deity and Eternity**



#### **1. Contrast the evidence for the human and the divine natures of Christ.**

The Scriptures present the Lord Jesus Christ as being at the same time perfectly human and perfectly divine. Because of this, He was both like and unlike other men. Jesus was revealed to be a man among men who was born, who lived, who suffered, and who died. Scripture is equally clear He was unlike man in that He was eternally preexistent, He was entirely sinless in His human life, His death was a sacrifice for the sins of the whole world, and He manifested His divine power in His glorious resurrection and ascension.

## **2.What are some of the evidences for the eternity of the Son of God?**

He had no beginning because He was from all eternity. In Isaiah 9:6 the prediction was given, "For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given." The distinction is obvious between a child who was born and the Son who was given. In like manner, it is stated in Galatians 4:4, "But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law." Accordingly, the eternal Son became in His incarnation "made of a woman."

## **3.How does the eternity of God prove His deity?**

Scripture states so often that Christ is eternal and that He is God. Only God can be eternal.



#### **4. What additional implications are there from His works that the Son of God is eternal?**

He antedates all creation therefore He must be eternal.

#### **5. How do the works of the Son of God prove His deity**

Only God could have created the Worlds.

## **6. How is the eternity of Christ supported by His titles?**

The titles of the Lord Jesus Christ indicate His eternal being. He is precisely what His names imply. He is "The First and the Last," "The Alpha and Omega," "The Father of Eternity."

## **7. How is the eternity of Christ supported by His other attributes?**

He is self-existent so he had no creation. He is said to have the attribute of Eternity. He is omniscient so if He knows all things He must have been present when knowledge began.

## **8.How do the attributes of Christ prove His deity**

Some of the attributes of God are mutually exclusive. For instance no two beings can be omnipresent. To say that Christ is omnipresent is to say He is God

## **9.How important to our Christian faith is the doctrine of the deity and eternity of Jesus Christ?**

Only God can die for sin, and only God can be eternal.
