Chapter Fifty: Judgement of Satan and Fallen Angels

A. Judgement of Satan at the Cross

Throughout the history of man, various judgments fell on Satan, including the judgment in the Garden of Eden which was inflicted on the serpent and the pronouncement anticipating Satan's ultimate downfall given in Genesis 3:15.

Christ in His death bruised the head of Satan and accomplished a complete victory. Through His payment for sin and the new birth He took back the Kingdom from Satan and broke his power over death that kept man in bondage.



B. Satan cast out of Heaven

At the midpoint of the Great Tribulation, a war takes place in heaven between Michael, the leader of the holy angels, and Satan the leader of the fallen angels. Satan and the fallen angels are defeated and cast out of heaven

In heaven Satan had been engaged in ceaseless accusation of the brethren and had "accused them before our God day and night." The accusing work of Satan, first introduced in Scripture in the Book of Job, is finally brought to an end

While nothing is said in this passage concerning the fallen angels, other passages indicate that they will be confined to two places on earth awaiting the final judgement. The two locals are Babylon and Edom.



D. Final Judgment of Satan

After the 1000 years are ended Satan gathers unsaved men and angels to fight against Christ.

There is immediate judgment by fire falling down from heaven. The Devil is cast into the lake of fire and brimstone tormented forever. The fallen angels are also judged, because they followed Satan's original rebellion against God some of the fallen Angels who co-habited with humans are already in a place called Tartarus awaiting the final judgement of being cast into the lake of fire and brimstone.

As Scripture makes clear, there are only two ultimate judgments, one the unending *bliss* of heaven, the other the unending torment of the lake of fire.

A. Judgement of Satan at the Cross

Satan's ultimate downfall given in Genesis

Gen 3:15 And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; **it shall bruise thy head,** and thou shalt bruise his heel.

Christ anticipated Christ's victory over Satan.

Luke 10:17 "Lord, even **the devils are subject** unto us through thy name."

Luke 10:18 "I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven"

John 16:11 "of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged."

B. Satan cast out of Heaven

Rev. 12:9 "the great dragon was cast out, that old ser pent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him"

Satan the Accuser

Rev 12:10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the **accuser of our brethren is cast down**, which accused them before our God day and night.

The accusing work of Satan, first introduced in Scripture in the Book of Job

Job 1:6-8 Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan came also among them. And the LORD said unto Satan, Whence comest thou? Then Satan answered the LORD, and said, From going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it. And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil?

C. Satan **bound** and cast into the abyss

Revelation 20:1-3 "I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years, And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season."

D. Final Judgment of Satan

Revelation 20:7-8 "And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison." "shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea.

Revelation 20:9 "Fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them."

Revelation 20: 10 "The devil that deceived them was **cast into the lake of fire and brimstone,** where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever."

This is the final doom of Satan, for his destiny is eternal fire which God prepared for the devil and his angels

Mat 25:41 Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:

Satan's original rebellion against God

Isa 14:12-15 How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations! For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High. Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit.

Tartarus not Hades

2 Peter 2:4 "God spared not the angels that sinned, but **cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness**, to be reserved unto judgment."

Cast into the lake of fire

Rev 20:13-14 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.
